

HUBERTUS WALD KINDERREICH / RULES

in the Hubertus Wald Kinderreich, children from the age of 5 can act like designers, architects or artists. They can shape, invent and construct, take photographs and create animated films, dress up or play with shadows. Adults will also discover unusual and innovative things in the supervised hands-on area.

Below are the rules that apply to the use of the space:

1. Children under the age of eight must be supervised by their parents or adult companions.
2. Bags, coats and similar items must be placed in the lockers in the foyer or next to the sanitary rooms.
3. Please take off your shoes and put them in the broom closet next to the door.
4. Costumes may only be put on by children and should be hung back on the hooks provided after the play.
5. Please do not throw books, small furniture and toys.
6. Planters and the table in the middle are not suitable for climbing.
7. For hygienic reasons, please refrain from eating and drinking in the children's realm.
8. Please treat the supervisory staff, the room and its objects with respect.
